PICPOUL DE PINET - COTEAUX DU LANGUEDOC

Talk about sensational value! These Guys know how to get the most out of the Picpoul and its little seaside appellation. A bracing note of orange zest, white pepper and ocean salinity leads to a fresh, snappy, yet doughy-yeasty, even slightly creamy palate, citrus zest, beet root and plum skin vying for attention in a manner reminiscent of a light but concentrated Gruner Veltliner. \$12.00



SANTA EMA RESERVE CABERNET –CHILE



The Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is 100% varietal and was also aged for 12 months in 100% new French oak. It offers abundant toasty black currants and blackberry liqueur on the nose. This is followed by a thick, rich wine with loads of black fruit flavors, ripe tannins, and excellent balance. \$11.99

STICKS PINOT NOIR- AUSTRALIA

This Pinot Noir has a brilliant bright red color with purple tinges. The nose is of berries, with cherry, raspberry, and strawberry, with noticeable spice. The fresh red berries are evident on the palate with cloves and fine tannins. \$15.99
